Instructions for Completing the ECEA Advancement Petition/Relegation Form

- 1. Fill out the Advancement Petition/Relegation Form and snail-mail or email it to the address below. If necessary, you may type your responses on a separate document and mail/email it (along with the Advancement Petition Form) to the address below.
- 2. Before submitting your form, make sure that every item has been completed. Fill in the date and sign the form.
- 3. Attach all supporting documentation (to the Petition Form) including event results, class results, finishing position, time differences (if applicable), etc. to back up your reason for petitioning.

NOTE: If the ECEA Referee considers your request to be reasonable and valid, you may be required to appear in person before the ECEA Petitioning Board (consisting of: ECEA Enduro & HS Committee Chairs and Referees, the event Referee, and the ECEA Referee). Upon receipt of this completed Form, the ECEA Secretary shall notify you when to appear. Shortly after the meeting date in which you appear, you will be notified by letter or email of the ECEA Petitioning Board's decision.

The ECEA will return to A or B classes only those riders who are totally non-competitive in the upper class and will not return a rider who would dominate the lower class returning to. A rider may only be returned **once** and, if applicable, will begin accumulating points through the AMA's Advancement System. B riders may not return to the C class except by appeal to the AMA. If a rider is caught competing in the wrong class, the rider will lose all championship points accumulated to date and be moved into the proper class.

Riders between the ages of 12 and 16 riding in the B class shall not be forced into the A class regardless of how many B races or promotion points they have. Riders in this age group may advance based on their own ability and competence.
